Lets Do It Afghanistan Cleanup Campaign:

Today 14 June 2015 the civil society from 10 provinces (Kabul, Logar, Parwan, Kapisa, Panjsher, Kunduz, Takhar, Ningarhar, Kunnar, Laghman) of Afghanistan participated in the two days Partnership Building Seminar, organized by the Bureau for Reconstruction and Development (BRD) Afghanistan in Kabul.

Members of the provincial civil society and participants of the seminar through a joint statement announced; The cleanup campaign will be organized on 8^{th} August 2015 in 10 provinces of Afghanistan.

Through this press release BRD and the CSOs from the 10 provinces, call upon all the national, international organizations, un agencies, local government institutions, elected bodies and politicians, religious scholars for their support and participation in the clean up campaign to gather with the civil society and local communities in the targeted provinces.

Lets Do It Afghanistan Cleanup Campaign is part of the "Lets Do IT World" clean up campaign to be implemented for the first time in Afghanistan in collaboration and support from the Lets Do It World Foundation based in Estonia and Estonian Ministry of Environment.

The campaign is a mass civic movement, focused on mobilization and active engagement of citizen through their voluntary participation for protection their own environment, keeps tidy their own city and towns and work for the wellbeing of their family, society and country at large.

The campaign will also facilitate effective collaboration among the local communities, civil society organizations, local government institutions and the private sector for achievement of the common goal.
